|  FOOD SCRAPS | Up to 30 gallons Any food or food by-product, including meat, bones and dairy. | 1 2 3 4 5 6 |
|  LEAVES & TRIMMINGS | Leaves, grass clippings, weeds, garden trimmings, and house plants. <i>No wood (even twigs), plastic bags, rocks, or sod.</i> | 2 3 4 5 6 8 9 |
|  CLEAN WOOD | Logs, brush, branches, lumber that has never been painted, stained, treated, or glued. <i>No dirt or rocks.</i> | 2 4 6 9 |
|  SPECIAL MATERIALS | <i>Daily Limits May Apply For fees, hours & specifications go to cswd.net</i> | FACILITIES |
| Appliances (Large) | Refrigerator, freezer, stove, dish washer, air conditioner, dehumidifier, etc.. | 4 6 10 |
| Batteries | Alkaline, lithium, rechargeable, and lead-acid. | 2 3 4 5 6 7 |
| Computers & TVs | Monitor, CPU, printer, scanner, computer peripherals, TV (any type). | 2 3 4 5 6 7 10 |
| Electronic Devices | Gaming devices, DVD & CD players, VCR, stereo equipment, phones, cameras, cables. | 2 3 4 5 6 7 10 |
| Fluorescent Bulbs | CFLs, tubes – straight, circline, and u-tube. | 2 3 4 5 6 7 |
| Mercury Containing Devices | Thermostats and thermometers. | 2 3 4 5 6 7 |
| Propane Tanks | Up to 20 lbs. Up to 100 lb. tank accepted at facility 6 only. | 2 3 4 5 6 7 |
| Scrap Metal | Items at least 80% metal; engines must be drained of all fluids. Small items only at facility 3 | 2 3 4 5 6 |
| Tires (With or without rim) | Bike, motorcycle, car, and truck tires. 20 tires or less at facilities 2, 4, 5 & 6. More than 20 tires and XL equipment tires facility 6 only Monday-Friday. | 2 4 5 6 |
| Used Motor Oil & Filters | 2 gallons or less per container Daily Limits Apply except for facility 7. | 2 3 4 5 6 7 |
|  HAZARDOUS WASTE | <i>Daily Limits May Apply For fees, hours & specifications go to cswd.net</i> | FACILITIES |
| Products with labels that state | "Warning," "Danger," "Poison," or "Caution" DO NOT belong in recycling or trash. | 7 |
| Automotive Fluids, Grease, etc. | Gas, oil, antifreeze, and lubricants. | 7 |
| Garden Chemicals | Fertilizers and pesticides. | 7 |
| Home Improvement | Paints, stains, thinners, varnish, adhesives, and tars. | 7 |
| Household Cleaners | Drain openers, acids, and strippers. | 7 |
