

Electronics **ALL**

TVs, monitors, computers & peripherals (up to 7 items) No charge
 Cell phones No charge
 Stereos, disc players, telephones, VCRs & other electronics \$0.50-5

Furniture & bulky waste

Mattress \$10-20
 Chair \$4-10

Hardcover books **ALL** No charge

Leaves & yard debris **ALL** No charge

Non-woody debris only.

Mercury light bulbs **ALL** No charge

General purpose tubes & CFL bulbs only. Limit 10.
 No specialty bulbs (tanning, neon, water filtration, etc.).

Mercury thermometers & thermostats **ALL** No charge

Limit 5.

Recycling **ALL** No charge

Plastic containers & packaging
 Paper & cardboard • Metal cans
 Glass bottles & jars
NO residual food or beverage.
 Must be empty, clean & dry!



Motor oil & filters **ALL**

Oil No charge
 Limit 15 gallons; 2 gallons/container max. NO water or other liquids. Dispose of empties as trash.
 Filters No charge
 From residents only; limit 5.

Propane tanks

20 lbs or smaller **ALL** No charge
 Limit 5 per day.
 20 - 100 lbs **W** \$5

Textiles **ALL** No charge

E.g. clothing, shoes, linens, fabric scraps. Must be clean, dry, and tied in plastic bag.

Tires **ALL** **W**

Up to 16" (car, mini-van, etc.) .. \$2.75 .. \$2.25
 16.5"-19.5" \$5.25 .. \$3.75
 20"-24.5" \$14
 Over 24.5" \$56
 Additional fee per tire on rim. . \$1



Food scraps **ALL**

up to 5 gallons \$1.50
 if paying for trash. . . No charge
 Any food or food by-product, including meat, bones, and dairy.
 Limit 30 gallons.

Wood

Clean brush, limbs, etc. **X** No charge*
 NO dirt, stones, ornaments, etc. Max 2' dia., 6' long.
 * **E M R S** Limit 3 cubic yards; \$10/cy after limit.
 * **W** Limit 6 cubic yards; \$5/cy after limit.

Clean lumber & pallets **X** No charge*
 NO dirt, hardware, strapping, plastic.
 NO plywood or painted, stained, or treated wood.
 Nails & screws OK up to 1/4" diameter.
 *Limit 1 cubic yard. \$5/cy after limit.
 Large truckloads **W** \$50/ton

Painted, treated wood C&D fees apply
 Loads over 1 cu. yd. may be redirected to a more suitable facility.

Plywood, OSB recycling **W** \$75/cy
 CLEAN, unpainted/unstained, untreated only.

Dirty stumps **W**
 Diameter up to 2' \$8.00 ea
 Diameter more than 2' \$80/ton

Scrap metal **ALL** No charge

Items must be at least 80% metal.
 Empty engines of gas & oil before dropping off.



Blue bin tip: No plastic bags!
 Plastic bags don't belong in the recycling container.
 Take back to participating grocery & hardware stores.

HOW TO USE THE DROP-OFF CENTER

Step 1: Come prepared to DIY

DOCs are do-it-yourself facilities. If you can't handle your materials yourself, please bring along a helper.

Step 2: Check in at the booth window

Tell us everything you plan to drop off, including items for which there is no fee, like batteries or scrap metal.

We need to know about all of the materials that come into our facilities for safety and data tracking.



Step 3: Park out of the way

The DOCs can get pretty crowded. For safety and efficiency, please ensure you're not blocking a path through the facility.

Please be considerate of other visitors' time and space.

Step 4: Drop off your stuff

Each collection container is clearly marked with signage.

If you have a question about where something goes, please ask a staff member! We're happy to point you in the right direction.

REUSE OPTIONS

Reuse stores

Humanitarian organizations

Online forums

E.g. Front Porch Forum, Craigslist, Freecycle, Facebook, etc.
