### Use non-toxic products where possible.





## What is household hazardous waste?

Household hazardous waste (HHW) includes any product that is:



Hazardous products may not be labeled with a particular symbol. You can easily identify hazardous products by reading packaging labels. Look for key words such as **Warning! Danger! Poison!** and **Caution!**

**Improper disposal of hazardous materials is illegal**—and it poses a risk to human health and the environment.

The materials collected at the Environmental Depot are shipped to a licensed facility where they will be disposed of or recycled in an environmentally sound manner.

## WE ACCEPT:

### Automotive Supplies

- antifreeze
- autobody filler
- brake fluid
- gasoline
- grease
- motor oil
- oil filters
- transmission fluid
- wax

### Cleaners

- ammonia
- chlorine bleach
- drain openers
- furniture polish
- oven cleaners
- rug/upholstery cleaners

### Garden Supplies

- fertilizers
- herbicides & pesticides
- poisons

### Health /Beauty Aids

- hair dyes
- nail polish/remover
- mercury thermometers

### Home Improvement Supplies

- glues
- paints & stains
- paint thinner
- roofing tar
- strippers & varnish

### Hobby Supplies

- photographic chemicals
- pottery glaze

### Miscellaneous

- ballasts & capacitors
- batteries
- fire extinguishers
- flea powder/shampoo
- fluorescent light bulbs
- propane cylinders
- mercury thermostats

## How to use the Depot

**Keep all products in their original, labeled containers** when possible, and pack upright in boxes. If a container is leaking, enclose it in another suitable container. **Never mix chemicals.**

**Check our schedule.** The materials we deal with are volatile and heavily regulated, so we have to close during afternoon hours for safe processing. Make sure you double check our hours before you come by!

**Be kind & wait in line.** If there's a vehicle ahead of you when you arrive, please wait for us to finish. Due to the dangerous nature of the materials we deal with, we can only serve one car at a time. Thanks for understanding!

## Fees

There is no charge for **Chittenden County residents** with household quantities of ordinary items. Fees may apply to specialty items and large quantities.

**Chittenden County businesses** that generate small quantities (up to 220 lbs a month) of hazardous waste *may be eligible* to use the Depot. An appointment is required; fees may apply.

**Out-of-district household residents** may use the Depot; fees apply.
