

Recycle Relay Race

The Recycle Relay Race will be run at each school that has tied in the Recycle Rally. Dates and times will be set up as soon as results are tallied by CSWD staff. All equipment will be supplied by CSWD, all you need to supply is the Relay Team, a space to run, and energy to Recycle Right. Below is an outline of how the relay race will work.

Step 1: Gather the Recycle Rally team (should be the students who conducted the survey but not necessary).

Step 2: The relay team will be given a basket of materials to correctly sort into Recycling and Trash.

Step 3: One person will pick up an item, run to the sort station, and discard the item in the correct bin.

Step 4: That person will run back to the team, tag off with the next person in line.

Step 5: Next person will pick up an item, run to the sort station, and discard the item in the correct bin.

Step 6: Repeat until all items from the basket are placed in a bin. CSWD time keeper will stop the watch when the last person crosses the finish line. That time will be recorded and used to award the bonus point when all schools have participated.

Step 7: CSWD staff will go through each bin and award 1 point for every correctly placed item.

Step 8: the ultimate winner will be announced the day after the last relay race is run.

Scoring

Fastest team gets 1 bonus point

1 point for every correctly placed item
