DEFINITION:

Skilled technical and manual work in operating and maintaining all aspects of the latex paint recycling program.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS:

Performs physical and mental tasks under strict safety procedures.

Assists in maintenance of recordkeeping system as to the acceptance, quantity, storage, and recycling of latex paint

Assists in deciding production schedule and maintaining adherence to that schedule within program expectations.

SUPERVISORY CHARACTERISTICS:

Works under the direct supervision of the Hazardous Waste Operator/Latex Paint Specialist.

EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED:

Collect, consolidate, and prepare latex paint for recycling or disposal including sorting paint into acceptable color and quality categories.

Identifies non-recyclable paint and paint that contains hazardous ingredients.

Sets up and cleans recycling filters and paint can consolidation equipment.

Packages paints for resale including filling, covering, cleaning and labelling containers.

Read, interpret, and follow technical manuals, and material safety data sheets for procedures and safety.
Performs equipment maintenance.

Operates pneumatic, electric and hydraulic powered equipment such as a drum mixers, can press, and a can opener as well as hand tools.

Sets up and operates consolidation equipment including a drum mixer, drum lifters, drum carts

Must adhere to District safety programs and policies.

Performs all other work as assigned.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

Ability to operate pneumatic, electric and hydraulic powered equipment such as a drum mixers, can press, and a can opener as well as hand tools.

Ability to operate forklift, power, and hand tools.

Ability to function under pressure and/or weather conditions and meet deadlines while maintaining a cheerful and helpful attitude.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Duties require frequent to moderate physical effort with occasional considerable strength and endurance in performing heavy manual labor for extended periods of time.

Undesirable working conditions with unpleasant elements with occasional high degree of tolerance to combinations of extremely unpleasant elements.

Potential risk of bodily injury may exist if safety procedures are not followed.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Ability to understand relevant physical and chemical principles, as it relates to the proper and safe handling of latex paint and paint additives brought to the facilities.

Ability to physically wear personal protective equipment.

Must be able to lift 60 pounds continually. Must be able to work standing the majority of the time.

RECOMMENDED QUALIFICATIONS:

Valid Driver's License.
